FIRST AID

Swallowed	Wash mouth out with water then drink plenty of water. If irritation develops seek medical attention

Skin	Remove contaminated clothing, wash thoroughly with soap and water. If irritation develops seek medical attention
Inhaled	Remove the source of contamination or move victim into fresh air. If irritation develops seek medical attention
First Aid Facilities	Normal washroom facilities

ENVIRONMENTAL DATA
